

What is the Nonprofit Profile?

NTCF's Nonprofit Profile is a way for you to update the Foundation on your organization, services provided, who you serve and your current funding needs. This is not a grant application or a request for funding. Foundation staff will use this information to learn about new projects happening around our 11-county service area. In addition, Foundation staff may provide your information to our fundholder families who may have interest in learning more about your organization. Foundation staff will reach out to you if they have any additional questions.

How do I complete the Nonprofit Profile?

To begin, you will need to access the Foundation's grant portal, HERE.

- If you are new to the Foundation's grant portal, you will need to create a new account. If you are a returning applicant, please use the same username and password to access the portal.
- Once your account is created, you will be taken to the applicant dashboard. In the top left corner of
 your applicant dashboard click on "APPLY" and you will be taken to the Nonprofit Profile, along with
 any other open grant applications at the Foundation. Once you've started your Profile, you may save
 and return until you are ready to submit.

Now what?

We encourage you to complete the Nonprofit Profile 1-2 times per year to keep the Foundation up-to-date on your capital campaigns, emergency needs, matching opportunities and new or pilot projects.
